

Traffic Management Plan

Objectives

- To prepare every student to be road safety conscious
- To prevent road accidents
- To provide an understanding of traffic rules and of the need to conform to these rules for the greater safety of all road users

When walking

- Use the kerb drill (stop, look, listen)
- Use footpaths, pedestrian crossings, overhead bridges, traffic lights to cross roads
- Be more careful at dangerous corners and intersections
- Follow the directions of school security officers, traffic wardens or police officers
- Wear light coloured clothing at night
- During wet weather, enter and exit the school using the side gate next to the D & T Block. The gate is linked to the sheltered walkway which leads to the nearby bus stops and the Bartley MRT station.

When travelling by Bus

- While standing at the bus stop, keep off the bus bay
- Flag bus in advance
- Avoid standing on steps of the bus
- Avoid leaning out of the bus as it might cause danger
- Do not misbehave in the bus, as this might distract the driver and disturb others on board.

When travelling by Bicycle

- Send your bicycle for regular maintenance to ensure it is serviceable
- Use safety gear
 - Protect your head from injury by wearing a safety helmet
 - Use elbow pads and knee pads to cushion the impact of a fall
 - Wear proper shoes, and make sure that the laces are always tied properly as this could get entangled with the pedals and other moving parts.
- Ride safely
 - Act as if you're a pedestrian – look right, left, and then right again. When the road is clear, push your bicycle across for better safety.
 - Use hand signals to warn other road users when you stop. Place the left foot on the ground and alight from the left side of the road.
 - Be extra alert at road junctions – these are accident-prone areas.
 - Stop your bicycle completely at “Give Way” and “Stop” signs.
 - Before crossing at junctions with traffic lights, always look to see if there are no vehicles coming from the left and right.
 - Ride in single file
 - Hold handles with both hands; do not hold onto another vehicle or cyclist
 - Avoid racing

**Notify OM if you are cycling to school*

When travelling by Car, Taxi or Chartered Bus

- Avoid leaning out of the bus or car as this is dangerous
- Do not misbehave in the bus, as this might distract the driver.
- Use seat belts (when provided)

When taking part in activities around the school premises

- Look out for on-coming vehicles
- Follow teachers' or instructor's directions

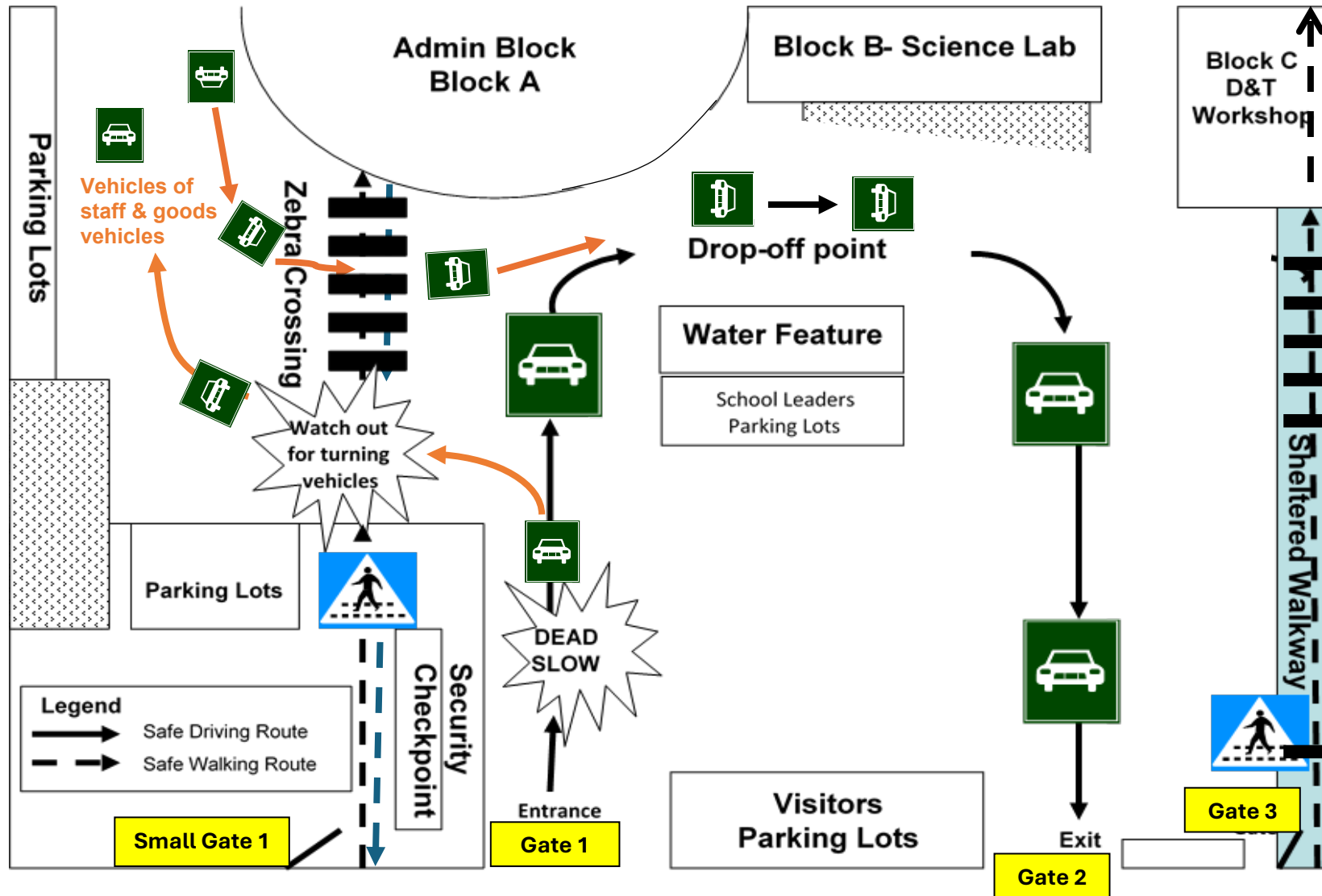
Parents or Guardians

- Follow traffic directions by security officers and traffic signs when dropping off children in school
- Enter the school at **Dead Slow Speed** for security check and to avoid mishaps
- Drop off child or ward at the foyer area and move off quickly
- Leave the school at the exit gate unless you are instructed otherwise.

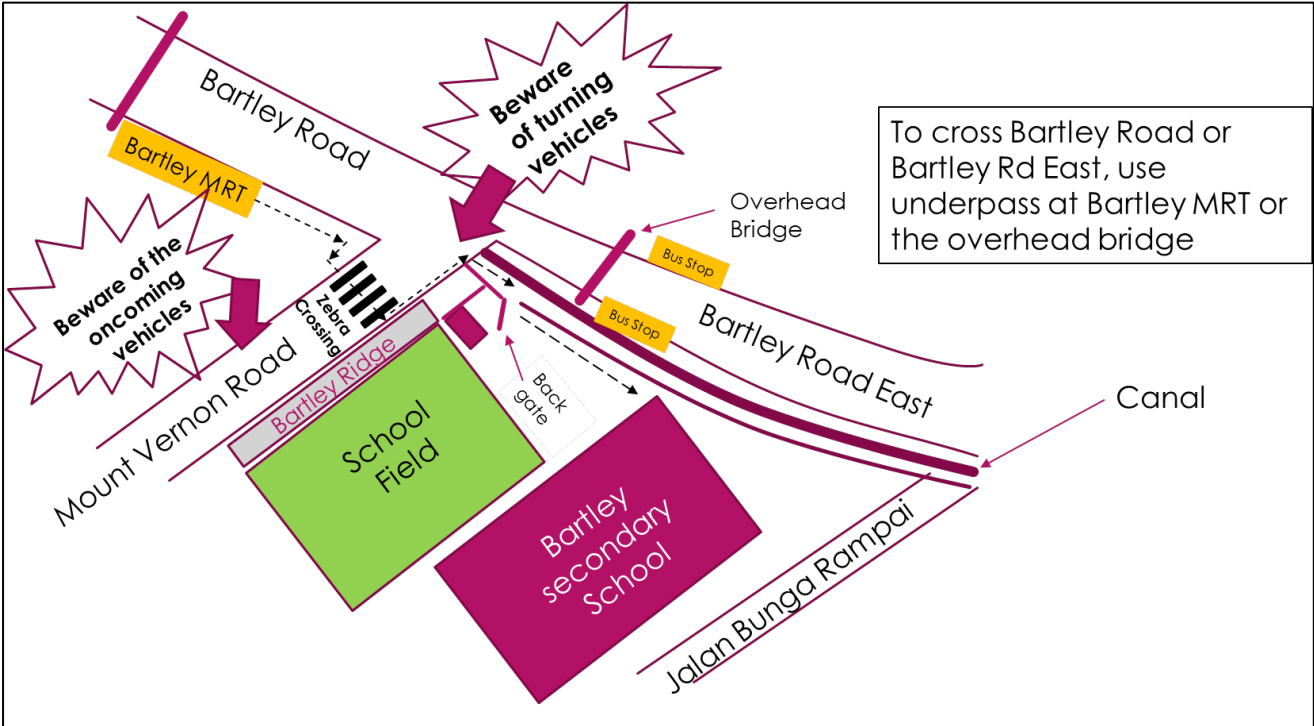
Access Gates and Opening Hours
